


# Steering the AI Revolution

of employees are embracing AI at work




Over **80%**


**72%**

of employees believe their direct leaders are ready for AI adoption.



Only **41%**


of employees feel senior leadership is prepared for AI initiatives.


desire more frequent discussions on AI.




Only **39%**

## AI Implementation Action Steps for Leaders




### Upskill and Reskill:
